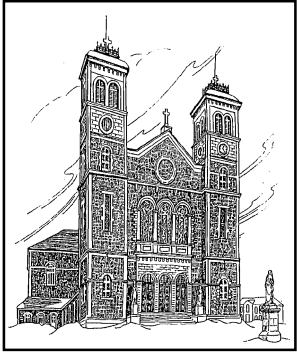

FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - FEBRUARY 5TH, 2017

Have you ever tried to make a delicious meal without salt? Or tried to find a set of matches in a sudden power outage? These two situations make us aware of how important both salt and light are to us. We hear today that true disciples are salt and light. This might suggest that they are like ordinary necessities, but there is more involved. For Israel, salt was so precious that it was included in covenant offerings made in the Temple. While today, we only have to flick a switch to light up our homes, Jesus' time, the only artificial light came from burning wax or oil. Today's Gospel passage is a challenge for all of us. If we are not salt and light for those whose lives we touch, then we are significantly impacting their lives in a negative way. Isaiah tells us today to share whatever we can with the hungry, the homeless, and the oppressed. Furthermore, we are to help take away the yoke that oppresses whole nations. Ignorance of the plight of much of our world is not an excuse for inaction. It is our responsibility as Christians, as fellow human beings, to become aware and to do our part. If we do not do this, if we buy into a culture that says that money and power are the measure of success, then the light we spread will be artificial, and the salt will be tasteless. We all make positive change, but we have to keep our own light shining ... you in your small corner, and I in mine, in other words, regardless of how little or how much power we consider that we have, we need to believe that every good work we do makes a real difference and we need to humbly 'let our little light shine'.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS ...

THE CATECHETICAL OFFICE at the Basilica provides parents with the resources to form their children in faith and prepare them to celebrate the sacraments. This process has two foci, namely, the home and the parish. This year we will provide some materials for families to use at home. We will invite families to get involved in the various liturgical ministries at the Sunday liturgy, namely, present the gifts of bread and wine, prepare the altar, carry cross and candles and proclaim the readings. The catechetical formation at the Basilica will also emphasize the liturgical year, especially the seasons of Advent, Christmas—Epiphany as well as Lent-Easter-Pentecost because they are extremely important for faith formation. This year we will celebrate a rite of welcome for children and families who are preparing to celebrate the sacraments of Confirmation and first Eucharist. Part of this celebration will be to present the child with a copy of the lectionary because the Word of God is very important in the faith formation of every Christian.
