

EASTER SUNDAY - APRIL 16TH, 2017

I have risen, and I am with you still, Alleluia! You have laid your hand upon me, Alleluia!

Too wonderful for me, this knowledge, Alleluia, Alleluia!

More than any day of the Liturgical Year, thanksgiving and gratitude are enveloped in Alleluia! The wonder and joy of the Easter Vigil spills over into our celebration of Easter Sunday. Each year we meet the figure of Mary Magdalene – early in the morning of the first day of the week at the tomb of Jesus. Each year, we gather around the tables of the Word and Eucharist, basking in the light of the Easter candle, to celebrate Jesus Christ risen from the dead! Along with Christians throughout the world, we renew the promises of our baptism, wait in joyful hope for the coming of our savior, and dedicate ourselves anew to service of God and each other. From Easter Sunday to Pentecost we will gather in the presence of the Easter candle and celebrate these fifty days as one great Easter. The tomb, a symbol of death, has become a symbol of life. Christ is indeed risen! God has intervened in human history and a new creation has begun.

SNOW CLEARING ...

THE CATECHETICAL OFFICE at the Basilica provides parents with the resources to form their children in faith and prepare them to celebrate the sacraments. This process has two foci, namely, the home and the parish. This year we will provide some materials for families to use at home. We will invite families to get involved in the various liturgical ministries at the Sunday liturgy, namely, present the gifts of bread and wine, prepare the altar, carry cross and candles and proclaim the readings. The catechetical formation at the Basilica will also emphasize the liturgical year, especially the seasons of Advent, Christmas—Epiphany as well as Lent-Easter-Pentecost because they are extremely important for faith formation. This year we will celebrate a rite of welcome for children and families who are preparing to celebrate the sacraments of Confirmation and first Eucharist. Part of this celebration will be to present the child with a copy of the lectionary because the Word of God is very important in the faith formation of every Christian.
